### Weekly Police Summary (13-19 November 2025)

It's that time of the Week!

Police in the Tweed Heads and Byron Bay areas arrested **21 people** and took legal action against **64 individuals** this week.

# **Key offence categories:**

- **27 traffic offences**, including drink driving, unlicensed/suspended/disqualified driving, drug driving, stolen vehicles, police pursuits, and one expired licence.
- 11 shoplifting/larceny charges
- 10 domestic violence-related charges, including assaults, AVO breaches, stalking, and property damage
- 9 drug possession or cultivation charges
- 2 knife possession charges
- 1 child sexual touching charge

#### Notable incidents:

- Repeat shoplifting offences by a 35-year-old man (court 12 Dec 2025)
- Theft of a motorised scooter and possession of a face covering by a 44-year-old man (court 19 Jan 2026)
- Two intoxicated men in Byron Bay—one driving on a QLD learner licence—both charged, licences suspended (court 12 Jan 2026)

# **Operation E-Voltage (E-bike Enforcement):**

- Continued crackdown on unsafe and illegal E-bike use, especially before Schoolies.
- A 13-year-old riding an illegal E-bike at 50 km/h and doing wheelies was dealt with under the Young Offenders Act; the bike was seized.

### **Operation AMAROK XII (Domestic Violence Focus):**

- Statewide results: **752 offenders charged**, **1,629 offences**, numerous warrant executions and compliance checks.
- In Tweed Byron: 6 DV offenders charged, 23 AVOs issued, and 100+ AVO compliance checks completed, with community assistance leading to locating wanted offenders.
