Tweed/Byron Police District – Weekly Update November 14 2025

In the past week, 29 people were arrested and a total of 64 faced legal action across Tweed Heads and Byron Bay.

Key points:

- **Domestic violence:** 10 people charged, including breaches of AVOs, assaults, stalking/intimidation, and property damage.
- **Assaults:** 4 people charged, including assaults on a police officer and a retail worker.
- **Sexual offences:** 2 people charged, including one child-related offence.
- **Traffic offences:** 27 people charged, including 13 drink-driving, suspended/disqualified driving, drug-driving, repeat offenders, and one driving with a long-expired licence.

Notable incidents:

- A 26-year-old woman charged with shoplifting and assaulting a retail worker.
- A 16-year-old charged with possessing digital blueprints for prohibited weapons.
- A 46-year-old Byron Bay man charged with sexual intercourse without consent.
- A 16-year-old involved in a police pursuit on an unregistered bike, with suspected stolen property.
- A 76-year-old man charged with multiple child sexual offences.
- Under **Operation Cyclesafe**, a 40-year-old was arrested after trying to flee police on a bicycle and was found with a homemade taser and theft tools.
- Operation E-Voltage continues targeting illegal e-bikes and helmet offences, with several youths charged and illegal bikes seized or destroyed.

Police responded to **960 calls for service in 12 days**, alongside many walk-ins and unlogged enquiries, ranging from quick resolutions to long-term investigations.
