

Operation E Voltage April 2026 – Ebikes

Tweed/Byron Police District, supported by Far North Traffic & Highway Patrol Command conducted a high visibility policing operation under the auspices of Operation E Voltage

Three noncompliant E bikes were seized:

Tweed Heads:

* Non-compliant cycle impounded after rider sighted police, discarded cycle and ran from the scene. Enquires continuing to locate owner.

* 13 year old rider was stopped riding non compliant; not wearing an approved helmet and using a hand held mobile phone to record police on several occasions prior to being stopped. Parent of youth in attendance and spoken to. Cycle impounded with enquires continuing

Casuarina:

* 15 year old male was stopped doing 'wheelies' on Grand Parade – non approved helmet being worn and cycle found to be non-complaint with Australian standards. Parent of youth in attendance and spoken to. Cycle impounded with enquires continuing

Police engaged with adults and youths throughout the day, educating on road safety and legislation surrounding the use of E bikes.
